Introduction of Members and Guests – Julie Zollinger had everyone present introduce themselves.

Sarah Schwarz moved to approve the agenda as written. Angie Werth seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried. Angie Werth moved to approve the amended minutes (the name of Angie Werth corrected) from the May meeting. Sarah Schwarz seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried.

Treasurer's Report- Mandy Ricke, Treasurer, reported we have \$13,728.87 in our checking account and savings accounts combined. We still need to pay for the carpeting which is \$6,000. She submitted an estimated yearly expenses/income showing that we had an income of \$28,415 last year. Patty McCullick suggested we put this information in backpacks to parents. This was moved to new business.

Mandy mentioned that calendars were purchased by Home and School and given to teachers as in year's past.

Communications- Thank you cards from teachers and students were distributed for everyone to read.

Parliamentary procedure for meetings – Julie reviewed parliamentary procedure and asked that those wishing to speak raise their hand and be called upon so that everyone can hear what is going on.

2009-2010 Officers and Committee Chairs – Julie recognized the officers and chairs for this year and expressed her appreciation for their willingness to serve. She said that committee chairs need to be sure to contact all volunteers on their volunteer list. The Vice President office remains vacant. If anyone is interested, they should contact one of the officers.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Hospitality- The Open House is September 17. This will be the first event for this committee.

Fundraising- Angie Werth showed everyone a copy of the parent letter that will go out. We will be selling Otis Spunkmeyer cookie dough as well as other food items, magazines and gifts. The kickoff date is September 3 with just one turn-in date: September 18.

Fun Night- Neysa Aiken said the committee is considering other dates besides the usual January date. Discussion followed and it was decided to let the committee decide on date options and present them to us at the next meeting.

Special Events- Jackie Lang said the first event will be the Ice Cream Social from 6:30-7:30 next Monday. The custodians will set up the tables and they plan to give away the new t-shirt as a prize in the guessing game. Someone asked if school supplies were to be brought the night of the ice cream social. Mr. Meagher said only kindergarteners are to bring their supplies so it was suggested a sign be put on the door asking parents to not bring in the supplies that night.

Budget – Julie Zollinger said that Home and School purchased phones and they have been installed in every classroom as well as new carpet in the hallways. A question was brought up regarding our contribution of \$1,000 toward Felten M.S. new elevated stage area. There was confusion on what exactly it looked like and how much use Wilson would get out of it. Mrs. Blackwell said that some kids have problems with the height of them. Sarah moved to table it for school staff to look at it and determine if it is appropriate for us to contribute to. Neysa seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. 50th Anniversary Time Capsule – Julie presented the time capsule to Mr. Meagher which included a DVD, 50th picture, thank you notes, etc. It will be opened in 25 years.
2. Sweatshirts & T-shirts—It was decided that the order form will go out September 1. There was discussion on what color to have the sweatshirts and whether we should have zip-up hoodies. Mandy suggested that we stay with Gone Logo since they had already done the setup for the logo for the t-shirts and it would be less expensive then. Angie moved to go with Gone Logo. Jackie seconded the motion.

All were in favor and the motion carried. Sarah moved to set up a committee (Mandy, Scott and Sarah volunteered to be on it) to decide the design, colors and price. Mrs. Blackwell seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried. Angie moved to put the budget expense sheet in backpacks along with the clothing order form. Patty seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried.

3. Grounds Cleanup— Mr. Meagher said that the grounds were in good enough shape that we didn't need to have a clean up night at this time.

NEW BUSINESS
