

Mini-SCOOP Guidelines



SCOOP will facilitate optimum student performance through empowering teachers with resources, support and accountability; enhancing targeted interventions for kids; analyzing data to guide curriculum and instruction.

1. **Identify** students in your grade levels whose **data** indicates a need (below benchmark, Strategic or Intensive, below grade level, etc.)
2. Does the **triangulation** of data indicate a need for an intervention?
3. Determine the **specific** skill where the child is failing.
4. Identify the **baseline** data that directly measures that specific skill that is poor.
5. Find a **research-based intervention** to address that specific skill (see SCOOP notebook).
6. Determine how to **administer** the RBI.
7. Determine how to **frequently measure progress** of the RBI.

If you do not have any student to discuss then you may use this time to collaborate with your grade level teachers on the new reading series or share resources, websites, etc. that would have a positive impact for students and learning in your fellow teachers' classrooms.

Attached you will find the guidelines for your groups to follow. Each group has at least two consultants who will be documenting the students who are At-Risk and who are in need of research-based interventions. The group will go through each of the guidelines for each child. This will be documented on a spreadsheet that each consultant will have. The consultant is not responsible for completing the SCOOP paperwork, they are just making sure we are keeping ourselves accountable to our students, parents and each other.
